This option is Building Aidable so long as the district confirms insufficient space is available for PreK classrooms in the district's elementary schools as determined by Office of Facilities Planning's Aid guidelines. Please note that an OCFS license is not required as it is a district owned location.

3. District -Owned Building, Community -Based Organization (CBO) Operated Program

As a district-owned building, the same conditions described above apply, but Building Aid will not be paid on capital construction projects if the district has a money-bearing lease agreement with the CBO.
