

From Standard Elements to Can-Do Statements

Can-Do Statement Structure

I can + **language function** + **context for communication** +
language skill* / **cultural knowledge***.

** Note that language skill and cultural knowledge may be implied.

I can identify characteristics of friendship in
Cicero's essay *D am citi* by listing relevant quotes.

I can compare educational practices of
Ancient Greece and the U.S. by
